

Volunteer Drivers for Young Carers Clubs and Activities

Why do we need drivers?

Drivers allow our young carers to attend the club nights and outings provided, giving them a chance to have some fun and spend time away from their caring role.

What we would like you to do?

We would like you to pick up and drop off at the club nights' venue, which take place on Thursdays after school, or outing collection points and targeted groups during school holidays. There are three options:

1. Pick up from the young carers' home and drop off at club venue or outing meeting point.
2. Pick up from club venue or outing meeting point and drop off at young carers' home.
3. Do both picks ups and drop offs. You may also like to consider becoming an activities

Application

If you are over 21 years old and have a clean drivers licence, please contact our Volunteer Co-ordinator Julia Durrant on 0300 777 2722. We would then ask you to complete an application form, a DBS check and attend a short training session on Safeguarding Young People. Documents we ask you to provide are a copy of your photo drivers licence, a copy of your insurance policy document (showing business use) and a copy of your MOT certificate.
